Prior Meeting Summary: The Meeting Summary of March 1, 2012 was approved.

Randy Johnson-RCSC Director of Bowling: Randy reported on the upcoming Sun City Bowling Tournament being held the last weekend of April and the first weekend of May. Applications are coming in slow which is normal for this time of year. League contracts for the fall leagues at both Bell and Lakeview Lanes are being processed, plus a new league is being formed for Thursday evening beginning in September of 2012. Painting of walls at Lakeview Lanes has been completed; however, results were not favorable with the dark color darkening the outer lanes. Randy will talk with Assistant General Manager Jim Wellman to see if a lighter color can be used to solve the problem.

Rafaela Ruby, USBC Representative: Ruby reported again on the importance of the May 12, 2012 meeting of the metro/state USBC as an increase in dues will be the topic of this meeting. Ruby is awaiting location confirmation.

John Nugent, President of the Bowling Hall of Fame: No report provided at this meeting.

Francine Scheffelmaier, Sun City Bowling Association: Francine reported on the October 13, 2012 Annual Meeting being held at the Lakeview Recreation Center. Randy Johnson is the guest speaker and will be offering insight to the various lane patterns being used and the lane conditions. August and September issues of the SunViews will inform all bowlers of this important event.

New Business: Randy Johnson was asked to verify pin placements at the Bell Lanes as it has been noted that pin placement is not in the proper location on the circled pin decks. Randy will check this issue. Problems with equipment breakdowns noted at Lakeview Lanes, which have been continuous, are also being addressed by Randy. Meetings with mechanics, pin chasers and desk people are being conducted to help resolve and address issues as well.

Old Business: Impact of new bowling alley in Surprise, Arizona was discussed. There was a consensus that it should not affect RCSC operations.
